Under new legislation CPTNB Council composition should: (i) reflect geographic representation (north, south, central N.B.) (ii) have between 5 and 7 members; and (iii) include members from different areas of practice and practice settings.

Also, our regulations allow for a maximum of 3 full terms, with some variability and possible extensions, depending on how positions have been filled over the years. Therefore, an individual is generally expected to be on Council from 6 to 8 years. After one has not served for at least 2 years, one can be nominated again.
