3.0 Canadian Physiotherapy Education Programs

To ensure the competency of Canadian-educated applicants, CPTNB requires applicants to have successfully completed an entry-level degree in physiotherapy from a physiotherapy program accredited with Physiotherapy Education Accreditation Canada (PEAC), or other programs which Council determines as being substantially equivalent.

3.1 International Physiotherapy Education Programs

To ensure the competency of Internationally-educated applicants, CPTNB requires applicants to have successfully completed an Educational Credentials and Qualifications Assessment by the Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators (Alliance) which conducts the credentialling assessments on behalf of regulators in Canada and which determines whether the education and qualifications are substantially equivalent to those of a Canadian-educated candidate.
