

Registration requirements for reinstatements

(not registered in the previous year in N.B. or elsewhere in Canada, but at some time in the past)

STEP 1- Registering as a Practising Physiotherapist in New Brunswick through CPTNB

You may apply for registration as a practising Physiotherapist with CPTNB if you have 1) evidence of Canadian citizenship, proof of permanent resident status or a valid work permit and 2) 1200 physiotherapy practice hours in the last five years.

To apply for registration with CPTNB, complete the [Online Registration Application](#). Before starting, review the [User Guide](#) for instructions on setting up your account.

Please ensure your application includes the following documents:

1. Evidence of Canadian citizenship via valid Canadian passport, birth certificate or citizenship card. Non-Canadian applicants must submit proof of permanent resident status or a valid work permit.
2. Proof of individual Professional Liability Insurance (PLI) from a Canadian insurance provider.
3. Proof of registration/licensure and professional standing in all other jurisdictions where you have been registered/licensed as a physiotherapist. This can be done through a regulatory history form or letter of professional standing. This information must be dated within the last three months and sent directly from the regulators to CPTNB at info@cptnb.ca.
4. Two signed letters of reference attesting to the applicant's good character. The letters must be dated, signed and of a professional nature, that is, not written by family members or friends. Form letters will not be accepted.

All documents must be submitted in English or French. Documents provided in a language other than English or French must be accompanied by a certified translation.

You will be notified by e-mail if we require additional documents to complete your application. It may take up to 5 business days to review your submission.

STEP 2 (OPTIONAL)- Applying for the CPTNB Acupuncture/Dry Needling sub-register

CPTNB registrants seeking to practise acupuncture or dry needling must apply to CPTNB for entry to the sub-register. Following successful completion of the acupuncture or dry needling training, the completed application must be submitted to CPTNB and registrants must receive confirmation of entry to the sub-register before starting to practice these modalities.

The certificates that were previously approved by CPTNB do not need to resubmitted.
